**"Will you remember me? Talking with adolescents about death and dying?"**



**Dr. Maryland Pao**

Dr. Pao is Clinical Director and Deputy Scientific Director of the National Institute of Mental Health Intramural Research Program, Bethesda MD, and is on the Clinical Faculty at Georgetown University, George Washington University and Johns Hopkins University Schools of Medicine. Dr. Pao was Chief of the Psychiatry Consultation Liaison Service at the NIH Clinical Center from 2008-2019, and now is Attendant. She is board certified in Pediatrics, General Psychiatry, Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Consultation Liaison Psychiatry. She is author of more than 130 papers, many of which address interactions between medical and psychiatric symptoms in pediatric oncology, pediatric HIV and other primary immunodeficiencies. She helped develop a suicide screening tool for pediatric emergency departments, and an advance care planning guide for adolescents and young adults. She received the 2012 AACAP Simon Wile Award for leadership in Consultation Liaison.
