Cristina Sadowsky, MD, Assistant Professor of Medicine and Rehabilitation, is the Clinical Director for the International Center for Spinal Cord Injury and Clinical Director of the Paralysis Restoration Clinic at the Kennedy-Krieger Institute at Johns Hopkins University, a nationally recognized center of excellence. She has published extensively on spinal cord injury and management in children and adults using activity-based rehabilitation therapy. She also has extensive experience in treating acute flaccid myelitis in children. Dr. Sadowsky is a member of national organizations and societies dealing with spinal cord injury and is a consultant to national research programs dealing with spinal cord trauma including the DOD and Department of Veterans Affairs. She has also chaired national conferences and has been a speaker at national and international spinal cord injury conferences.
