She has published extensively on spinal cord injury and management in children and adults using activity-based rehabilitation therapy. Dr. Sadowsky is a member of national and international organizations and societies dealing with rehabilitation and disability and is a consultant to national research programs dealing with spinal cord trauma including the DOD and Department of Veterans Affairs. She has chaired national conferences and has been a speaker at national and international spinal cord paralysis related conferences.
