Dr. Babak Sarani, MD



Our guest speaker for October 3rd is Dr. Babak Sarani, MD, Director of Trauma Surgery at GW Hospital. Babak Sarani graduated from the George Washington University School of Medicine and Health Sciences in 1997. He then completed his training in General Surgery at GW in 2004. Following this, he completed fellowship training in Trauma and Critical Care Surgery at the University of Pittsburgh. He began his career as an Assistant Professor of Surgery in the Division of Trauma, Emergency Surgery, and Critical Care Surgery at the University of Pennsylvania. He returned to GW in 2011 where he is the Founder and Director of the Center for Trauma and Critical Care at George Washington University Hospital, its Level 1 Trauma Center. Since coming to GW, he also created the trauma ICU and launched its first critical care ground and air transport program.
